- For the Lord to bless the extended ministry of GRS in Mexico and beyond. Pray for Jason Boyle as he oversees training men for the ministry in Latin America.

Pray for wisdom for the Mission Board as it oversees the work of our missionaries and visits the mission fields. Note the general requests listed under the mission fields below and then see the specific requests from the missionaries on page 10. Pray for direction from the Lord regarding new fields of service.

- **Czech Republic**—Milos Solc, a former member of Toronto FPC, is an ordained FPCNA minister living in his native Czech Republic where he is seeking to establish a Free Presbyterian mission church. Remember the faithful, committed people who attend the services, that God will bless them with household salvation. Pray that they will know God’s grace and power as they continue to evangelize in an atheistic environment.
- **Jamaica**—The needs in Jamaica are great, ranging from national men called by God into the ministry, to a lasting work of grace done in the hearts of children. The Friday night children’s meeting is a vital ministry. Richard Craig heads up the work and is studying under care of the FPCNA for the ministry, and Randy Gunnings assists in preaching. Their responsibilities include overseeing the work, driving the bus, and maintaining the property. Pray they will know God’s power in preaching and much grace to be a vibrant witness in the community. Pray for the spiritual growth and safety of everyone in the congregation.
- **Liberia**—Rev. David DiCanio and Joanne Greer labor in Liberia. Joanne is involved in Bible clubs, Sunday schools, music lessons, teaching reading, and preparing curriculum for the possibility of a future Christian elementary school. David is overseeing the radio station in Duazon, preaching in Paynesville, overseeing the running of the bookstore, and doing the accounting and government corporate paperwork for the mission. Pray that the rest of the funds needed to purchase a second reliable vehicle will soon come in.
- **Mexico & the Dominican Republic**—Pray for Jason and Danielle Boyle and their church in Mexico City. Pray the Lord will help them in the work of the ministry, that the Lord will raise up men to serve as elders in the church and also as pastors for needy areas of the city and surrounding area. Pray for the sister churches that they work with, including Lalo Peña, in Veracruz, and Ramón Sosa, in the Dominican Republic. Lalo and Ramón are under care of the presbytery. In addition to pastoring their churches, they have been taking courses through GRS. Ramón has finished his classes and been licensed to preach by the FPCNA presbytery. Lalo should finish in the spring of 2022.
- **South Korea**—The mission work in South Korea is an outreach of Korean FPC in Greenville, S.C. Pray for Seongku Lee and his family as he seeks to plant a Free Presbyterian church in Gwangmyeong, which borders Seoul. Seongku, who is a native of South Korea, attended Korean FPC while he studied at Bob Jones University. When he returned to South Korea in 2014 he saw a dramatic increase in secularism and compromise in the Korean church and a clear need for a Free Presbyterian church that will be gospel-centered with biblical worship. In addition to services on Sundays and a prayer meeting, he holds Bible studies for college students.

- That the Liberia Telecommunications Authority would continue to grant the needed licenses.
